

RULES OF REHAB GOLF SOCIETY (RGS)

1. Every member of RGS shall be bound by and submit to the society rules, the rules of golf at The Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, the by-laws of courses played and by any RGS society rules on the day.
2. Only paid up members are called full members and may vote by post.
3. Alterations to the rules of the society will be by recommendation of the committee and agreed by members on a 2/3rds majority vote.
4. Annual General Meetings will be by postal ballot from items requested through members. The ballot will be sent by the secretary within one month of the final golf event of the year. Requests and recommendations will be returned to members before the first match of the next year.
5. The RGS committee has power to make by-laws for the benefit of members of the society.
6. Officers of the club will be:-
 - President - for life or until requested to leave
 - Captain – for two years
 - Events – until requested to retire
 - Secretary – four years
 - Treasurer – until requested to retire
7. Subscriptions are due by 1st February annually.
8. The society treasurer will open a bank account with three signatories from the committee, prepare accounts annually, and present the accounts to the members on the postal vote.
9. Part of any surplus shown on the income over expenditure account prepared by the treasurer will be allocated to the charity fund. This amount will be approved by a majority vote of the RGS members, on recommendation of the executive committee, on the postal ballot. This fund to be used for the purchase of equipment and maintenance within the Rehab Centre for cardiac patients up to the amount shown in the fund. Should the RGS committee be approached by the General Manager of Cardiac Rehab for a special purchase an extraordinary postal ballot will be issued.
10. RGS can only be dissolved and liquidated by agreement of a majority of members at an AGM. All assets including bank balances and trophies will be given to the Cardiac Rehab Charity as a donation.
