INTRODUCTION OF A HANDICAP SYSTEM

After each meeting the participants score cards to be collated.

A result sheet be prepared for publication to all members.

The accumulated points scored on the day to be averaged by dividing total points scored, by the top 80% of players.

A buffer zone of Average Score -2 to +2. No change in handicap

Handicap adjusted for any player outside of buffer zone, by 1 stroke for up to 2 points above or below the buffer zone, and by 2 shots for 3 or more points above or below the buffer zone. Up to a maximum handicap of 28 for men and 36 for ladies.

A revised handicap schedule be prepared in readiness for the next golf event.

Any new member joining the society to play from official club handicap. In the absence of an official handicap we will accept the player's word, however that player will not be able to win a prize and will not obtain a society handicap until 2 competition cards have been submitted.

Visitors will be welcome to play in the society events but will not be eligible for a prize. If any such visitor subsequently joins the society previous scores will count toward the 2 card requirement.
